

Team Requirements Presented by Relay For Life SHIZUOKA Execution Committee

1. A team is not a guest, but a host to contribute to the promotion of the event together with the execution committee.

Please note that the primary guest for this event is a 'survivor'. We would like other people than survivors to have the same feelings as the host and to work in cooperation with the execution committee, as much as possible.

2. The specific team activities are as follows: 'enlightenment', 'event (stage performances and activities)' or 'volunteer', etc.

In the 'enlightenment' activity, it is our intention to appeal 'pleasantly' to the participants to feel something familiar to 'cancer', to dispel any sense of fear or misunderstanding about cancer, to acquire knowledge about preventive and therapeutic measures, and to change people's minds so that they can participate in a crusade against cancer by themselves. Would you please perform team activities, e.g. by offering games or wearing fancy dresses, in cooperation with our enlightenment section?

The 'event' activity can be categorized into 2 sections; stage performances and activities pumping up the entire site. In the stage performances, there is a time limit and also some guest performers invited, therefore any applicant team should make an entry previously and then our event section will provide you with detailed information separately.

As there is a variety of activities which are performable for the entire site (the ones performed during the whole event or in the designated length of time, etc.), please let us have a discussion with you separately. Maybe you can a bit break out of bounds in such activities, [where please 'enjoy yourselves' anyway](#). Your cooperation would be appreciated.

As the volunteers shall be mainly made up of school students, it can be assumed that there would not enough number of volunteers during night. Our volunteer section may ask you separately, but it would be appreciated if you could participate in any volunteering activities as a team.

3. Please work in cooperation with the concept of this event '[Hospitality](#)'.

We would like you to make a plan for the '[Hospitality](#)' in advance such as drink/food services or game offers, etc. by coming over each team tent so that you can have well communication with other participants.

We hope that there would be a small interaction between participants all over the site. If such interactions are progressed, it would become possible to have a stamp rally between team tents, for which we would like to think, make a plan and carry it out all together with a motto of '[enjoy ourselves](#)'.

4. The fund-raising activities should be made preferably from today till the day of the event.

Please note that the main purpose of this event is to collect contributions for a crusade against cancer. Thus, we would like you to continue the fund-raising activities as long as possible till the day of the event. It would be appreciated if you could raise even a small amount of contributions by appealing to the people the meaning of the event individually.

On the day of the event, please prepare for collecting contributions via such activities as mentioned above.

5. We have the following suggestions to create an enjoyable and meaningful event:

How about honoring teams in the closing ceremonies? It should be fun to think about the awards together, such as 'the funniest team', 'the most brilliant team', 'the most fund-raised team' or 'the most powerful team', etc. It would be also a good idea to vote between teams.

Such ingenuity is all to enjoy ourselves. Putting aside any extra prizes, we will be pleased to have your own ideas!
